Thursday: Thursday (Knockout rounds) matches will be a seeded draw released Wednesday evening after the conclusion of the qualifying round.

The Knockout rounds are scheduled as follows;

- First round matches scheduled from 9am
- Quarter-final matches from 11am
- Semi-final matches from 1.30pm
- Super 6 Final match from 3pm
- Presentation 5pm (approx.)

After each Super 6 Knockout match, participants and family are encouraged to stay and watch the next round through to the Super 6 Final and presentation, however they are able to leave at their leisure.

PRACTICE ROUNDS:

Tuesday: From 8:00am (roll up start – check in at Homestead)
Friday: From 8:00am (roll up start – check in at Homestead)

No cost for junior participants, \$40 green fees for adults.

PRACTICE AREA:

There is no formal driving range at Ratho Farm Golf Links, however the following practice areas will be available for participants prior to Wednesday & Thursday's competition rounds;

- 18th green/putting green:** Players may practice on the 18th green prior to commencing their qualifying round (Wednesday).
- 18th fairway:** Players can use their own balls (or supplied balls and collect) hitting back down the 18th fairway with irons only.

HIRE BUGGIES:

Limited pull buggies/trollys are available for hire (no motorised carts). Participants are encouraged to bring their own.

COMPETITION RULES:

The top 16 gross scores (boys & girls combined) from Wednesday 18 holes will qualify for Thursday's Super 6 Knockout matches. The next gross scores will qualify for a second flight of matches.

The event will be governed by the Rules of Golf and *Tasmanian Junior Super 6 Competition Rules* in conjunction with the Local Rules of Ratho Farm Golf Links (supplied upon registration).

ACCOMMODATION & FACILITIES:

The accommodation at Ratho Farm consists of several old farm buildings lovingly restored into boutique rooms. Equipped with modern features but still retaining elements of the original masonry and carpentry, the result is a beautiful fusion of old and new. Un-sportsman like behaviour (including bad language and club throwing) will NOT be tolerated under any circumstances. Players may be subject to discipline by the Event Committee, and to possible disqualification for such a breach. Please remember that players, caddies, family members and spectators are guests of our host venue, so please respect this privilege and act appropriately.

DRESS REGULATIONS:

A neat, casual dress code applies to all participants and visitors.

COVID-19 REGULATIONS:

The event is subject to Government & Public Health advice at the time. Current social distancing requirements include;

- Keep 1.5 metres away from others wherever possible.
